



Announcement by the Office of National Digital Economy and Society Commission
Subject: Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts for Performing Duties
(No Gift Policy) of the Fiscal Year B.E. 2568 (2025)

Corruption is a serious problem that all sectors must work together to overcome this issue, to foster transparency within the agency, create values and maintain an honest culture in the performance of duties. The Office of the National Digital Economy and Society Commission hereby pledge that all executives and officials have intention of not accepting neither gifts nor profits from performing our duties, both before and after performing our duties which would cause corruption and misconduct at the present and in the future. And request all executives, civil servants, and officials to abide by the policy as follows:

- 1) All Civil servants and officials are prohibited from accepting presents from all stakeholders on any occasion.
- 2) All Civil servants and officials are prohibited from offering presents to all stakeholders on any occasion.
- 3) Expressions of congratulations, good wishes, welcomes, or condolences on various occasions are commonly conveyed through traditional customs. It is appropriate to use greeting cards or electronic formats or well-wishing cards instead of giving physical gifts.

The National Digital Economy and Society Commission would like to express its gratitude for the congratulations, good wishes, and moral support received from all external parties contacting the office. We are pleased to continue fulfilling our duties with integrity and fairness in accordance with ethical principles.
